QUESTION:

In your articles you use the English Standard Version when referencing scripture. Why do you not use the original King James Version?

ANSWER:

"We use many quality translations, especially the NIV and ESV, in part since those are versions most people are reading. Our Bible commentary site, BibleRef.com, offers the KJV as one of the parallel versions users can read. The KJV isn't "original," in the sense that there were English translations of Scripture both before and after it. For instance, if your Bible version is corrupt or misleading, then your articles' interpretation is going to be the same. Jeremiah 23:36 - "And the burden of the Lord shall ye mention no more: for every man's word shall be his burden; FOR YE HAVE PERVERTED THE WORDS OF THE LIVING GOD of the Lord of hosts our God". As a result I am disappointed in this site and don't recommend it.
